

Japanese Flute "SHINOBU"



Overview

SHINOBU is a Japanese traditional flute used for Shinto music and the traditional festivals.

There are three keys are available, SNO-04(Bb) and SNO-03(B) are well used for Shinto music and the festival, and SNO-02 is for ensemble with other instruments and education to learn Japanese and western songs.

Easy to handle

Because SHINOBU is made by resin, it can be washed with water and always kept clean. The hole is designed to be easy to hold, making it easy to do fingering.

About the keys of Suzuki SHINOBU

The Shinobue uses 13 different keys depending on the song being played. Suzuki has well-balanced high and low tone, and the most commonly used three-keys of Bb, B and C major are available. Choose the best SHINOBU according to the type of music or form being played, such as performance of Japanese orchestra or Classical music, ensemble with a Western Musical instruments or solo playing.
